Join us for the Check & Connect Comprehensive Implementation Training at the Medford School District Office in Medford, Oregon.

Training objectives

The Comprehensive Implementation Training provides participants with a thorough overview of Check & Connect and its background; information about how to prepare their site to implement Check & Connect; and the information, competencies, and skills needed to be an effective Check & Connect mentor.

Participants will learn and understand —

- The core components and elements of Check & Connect
- How Check & Connect was developed, its theoretical underpinnings, and its evidence base
- The eleven steps for Check & Connect preparation, implementation, and evaluation
- How to implement Check & Connect with fidelity
- The role of the Check & Connect coordinator
- The role and expectations of the Check & Connect mentor
- Check & Connect mentor competencies and skills

Cost

Who should attend

Education administrators, lead staff (decision-making stakeholders), Check & Connect site coordinators, and Check & Connect mentors.

Training materials



Participants receive a copy of the Check & Connect manual, printed resource materials, and access to electronic implementation forms.

The Check & Connect implementation manual walks readers through the Check & Connect implementation process, outlining the key components, describing the steps of implementation, and presenting the underlying theories and research, including the four types of student engagement (academic, behavioral, cognitive, and affective) and the importance of intervening both directly with students and indirectly through enhancing students' home and school contexts. Additionally, the manual provides guidance on options for implementing Check & Connect with fidelity to its principles and strategies, while also responding to local school and community contexts.
